

~ 2002 Jaguar Cup Invitational~

The Mighty Bluebird White team made their fourth consecutive final of the 2002 fall season and won their third tournament of the year in the 2002 Jaguar Cup Invitational. The Bluebirds won their first game 6-0 over LRFC '90 White, they won their second game 5-0 over FC United '90, they won their third game 4-0 over Blitz United '90, they won their fourth game 3-0 over the Arkansas Comets and they won their fifth game 2-1 over LRFC '90 White. The Mighty Bluebirds outscored their opponents by a total of 20-1 winning their second consecutive Jaguar Invitational.
